The 2012 State Street Scholars Program

The State Street Scholars Program runs from August 20, 2012 to the end of the school year in May 2013. Interns will have opportunities to learn about various State Street jobs and career paths that align with their field of study and majors. Through on-the-job experience, interns develop their business, financial and analytical skills.

To be considered for the State Street Scholars Program you must meet the following requirements:

- Current students in good standing with an expected graduation date between May 2013 and December 2015, and a minimum of 70 credits earned toward their undergraduate degree
- Overall G.P.A. of 3.0 or higher
- A major in Management, Finance, Accounting, or Economics
- U.S Citizenship or Permanent Resident of the U.S.
- Knowledge of MS Office applications and spreadsheet proficiency
- Good organizational skills and the ability to prioritize assignments under tight deadlines
- Attention to detail
- Ability to work as a team player

- Good interpersonal and communication skills in both verbal and written forms
- Ability to work 20 hours per week (2-6 PM Monday – Friday) in addition to completing two UMass required classes per semester (6 credits)
- Ability to complete a 10 day period of full time training (August 20 through August 31, 2012)
